- * Other comments to assist selection process.

Narrative should be typewritten, no more than two pages, and have no more than 8 lines per topic.

The applicant's school counselor, academic advisor, or administrator must endorse each application to verify enrollment. Financial awards are remitted directly to student accounts on or about July 1. Formal recognition takes place at the "2013 Scholarship Awards Dinner" at the Army & Navy Club in Washington. The 2014 Awards Dinner date is Wednesday September 17. Up to 12 awards of \$3000 each will be granted in 2014. Decisions relating to Award are by the Post only and are final.
